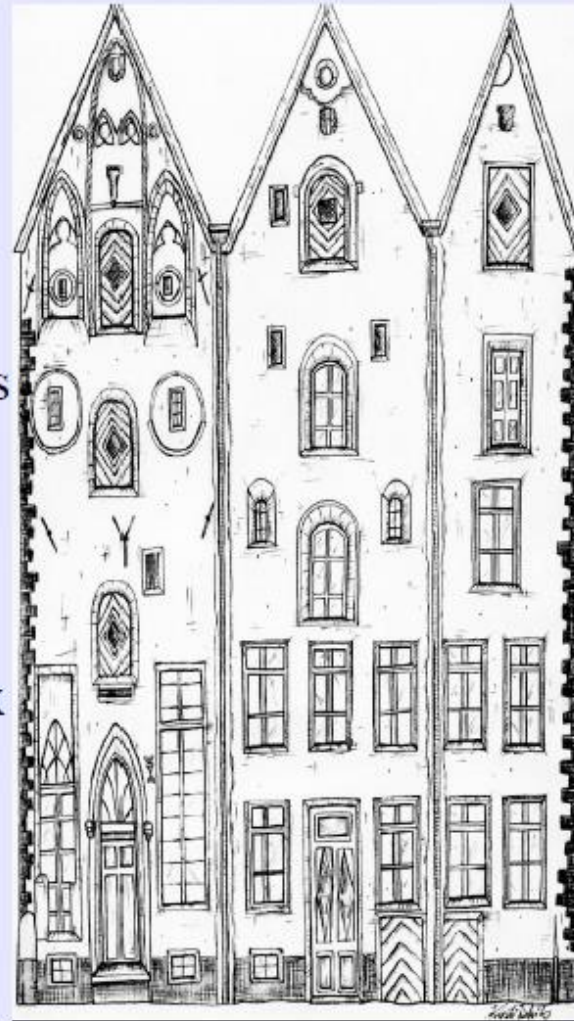


Welcome to the game
